

Princesses' Challenge Ice Drop

This Ice Drop was designed for the Disney's Princess Challenge by Dimz Naimor from the Ice Drop group on Facebook. All my princesses Ice Drop are done with the same pattern using the color scheme of each

princess.

MATERIALS:

Shuttle and Ball or Needle and Ball

3/4" dome glass gem

Thread size #10 in "Princess" color scheme (see photo at the end)

24 "E" or size 6 beads

ABBREVIATIONS:

(b): bead, slide bead into position.

NOTE: All beads are going to be inserted on the ball thread. Fill shuttle with 3 yards (or a little more to be sure in case the beads are bigger).

The Ice drop is done in one pass. You'll make rings with letters (A, C, E, etc.) to make the front base and rings with letters and numbers (A1, C1, E1, etc.) to make the back base. Only rings with letters are shown on the diagram.

Round 1:

Ring A: 5 - 3 - 5.

Ring A1: 5 - 3 - 5.

Chain: 8.

Repeat around until 6 rings are made on the back. Insert the gem before closing the 6^{th} ring on the front base.

Don't cut.

Round 2:


Chain: 6 (b) 6. Join between chains.

Repeat around. Don't cut.

Round 3:

Chain: 8 + (join to previous chain before the bead) 5 (3b) 5 + (join to the same chain, after the bead) 8. Join between chains and join again, twice, over the rings on the base, making a double lock join. This will create the "blip" of color over the rings.

Repeat around. Cut and hide ends or make a hanging loop.
